#### Important Safety Information

Children are very observant and at a young age will mirror the actions of their parents and siblings, such as unlocking and opening a window. Opening a window for children (5 and under) could pose a risk to their safety. The Metal T-Handle is an accessory device that may make it more difficult for young children (5 and under) to open a window. Windows are used for escape and rescue in an emergency such as a fire, and must remain operational at all times. Once your children reach an age where they fully understand how to properly interact with the windows in your home, reapply the handle. Teach your children how to properly interact with a window and how to use it for an emergency escape.



#### 1. Remove and Install Handles

- Remove Existing Handle by loosening set screw.
- Place new Metal T-Handle on operator stud and fasten by tightening set screw.
